

The Office Group Awarded for Environmental Excellence

2nd July 2010 The Office Group has won the EECO award for innovation in energy efficiency and carbon reduction. EECO recognised The Office for saving carbon through water harvesting and grey water recycling, installing solar thermal water heating, installing insulating green roofs, reducing the need for energy through better design, cutting carbon by turning existing buildings into better buildings and other practical energy reduction measures.

The Office Group and other winning organisations were singled out by Camden Council as a cut above the rest, leading the way towards achieving the council's vision for a low carbon, low waste borough of opportunity. All winners were selected by a panel of experts including [Envido](#), [Camco](#), the Bloomsbury Combined Heat and Power Consortium and the Mayor of London's [Green 500 scheme](#).

The Office Group received the award from Councillor Angela Mason, Deputy Leader of Camden Council, on 1st July at an event hosted by the council at the CBI Conference Centre. The awards are open to all organisations based in the London Borough of Camden, or that work to achieve an environmental benefit within the borough.
